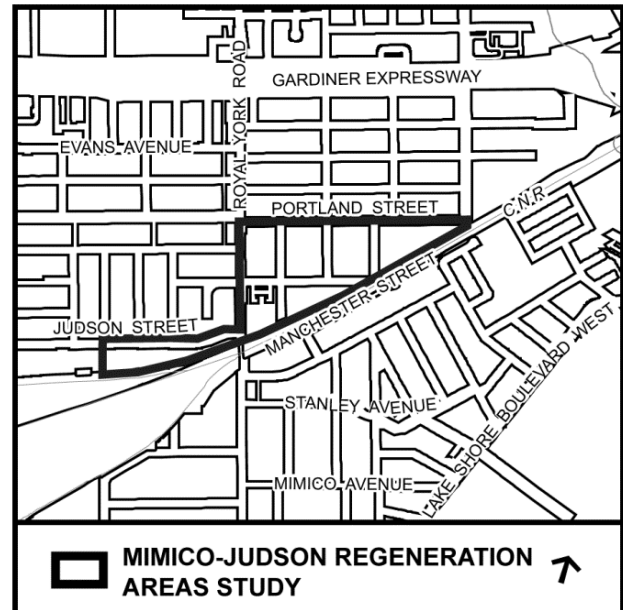


MIMICO-JUDSON REGENERATION AREAS STUDY

The Mimico-Judson Regeneration Area Study was initiated in 2013 to establish a detailed policy framework for the lands within a study area bounded by Portland Street, Royal York Road, the Rail Corridor and Judson Street (see map). Staff have drafted a Directions Report and a draft Secondary Plan based on the key findings of the Regeneration Area Study that will be considered by Planning and Growth Management Committee.
